



BUDTENDERO

These customer-facing positions are great opportunities for friendly, outgoing people. In addition to operating point of sale (POS) systems, budtenders must be able to educate new cannabis users and explain unique elements of a product based on the customer's needs and preferences.



Like traditional retail businesses, dispensary managers oversee the daily operations of the store from opening to closing. Responsibilities include managing product inventory and employee payroll, overseeing the employees ranging from budtenders to delivery drivers and making sure the store meets all regulatory standards.



These positions can also branch out to cultivation/production sectors but are often hired by cash-only retail businesses that are vulnerable to theft. These positions often go to applicants who have received firearms training and may have a background in law enforcement or private security.

O RECEPTIONIST

This position is often the first person seen by a customer when they enter a store/dispensary. Their roles can include managing incoming phone calls, email correspondence and any clerical work, in addition to checking the identification and/or medical documents of customers who enter the store.

^{***}All persons allowed to work if they are 21+ years of age, obtained an Agent Card from the Nevada Cannabis Compliance Board (CCB), and had a background check. Current law states an employee cannot have been convicted of an excluded felony offense. Additional experience and education level is required based on position.
